Scott Barklamb **Executive Director, Policy and Public** **Affairs – AMMA**

As Executive Director, Policy and Public Affairs of Australia's resource industry employer group AMMA, Scott Barklamb is responsible for policy and advocacy, media, public affairs and government relations.

This executive role requires people leadership and management of a dedicated group AMMA professional and administrative personnel.

Scott came to AMMA from the International Organisation of Employers (IOE) in Geneva; the peak global body representing employers' organisations in more than 140 countries.

As Senior Adviser overseeing the IOE's global employment and workplace relations policy portfolio, Scott has represented and advised employers' organisations throughout the world on labour market, macroeconomic, and workplace policy, as well as emerging considerations such as international industrial campaigns, international collective agreements, and links between corporate social responsibility and workplace relations.

He has coordinated employer advocacy to the G20 and international labour ministers' forums. During his time in Geneva, Scott has worked extensively on behalf of employers with the International Labour Organisation, the World Bank, the OECD, the WTO and other international organisations.

Prior to 2009, Scott was Director, Workplace Policy with the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI), representing Australian employers on workplace relations policy, employment regulation, and minimum wages.

In this role, Scott was the lead employer advocate in both national wage cases and major national test cases, including those on redundancy and work/family balance. Scott has also represented employers in Australia's peak national consultative forums.

Before joining ACCI, he was a senior manager with the Western Australian government, overseeing policy development and implementation on workplace relations, minimum wage and employment policy.
